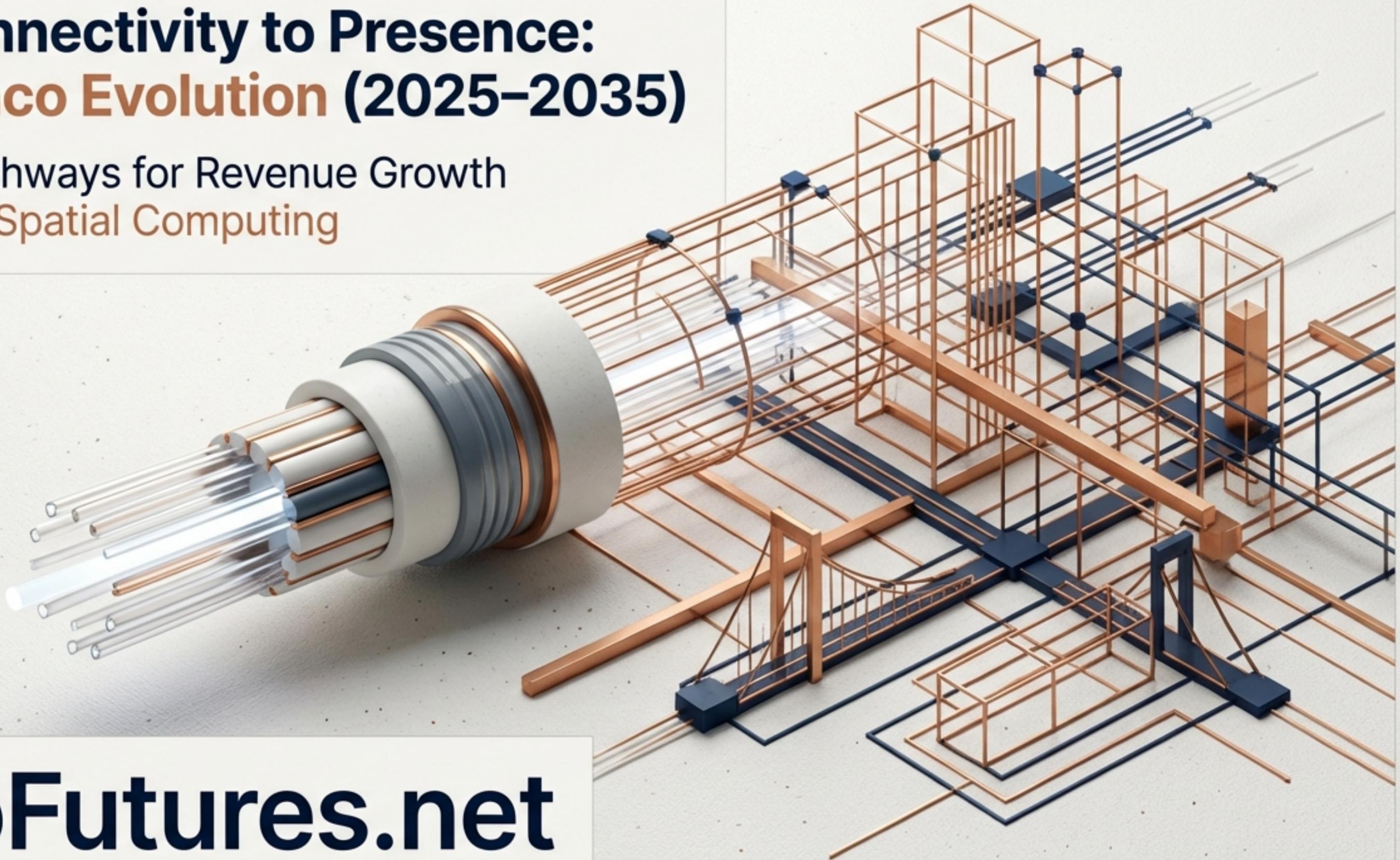

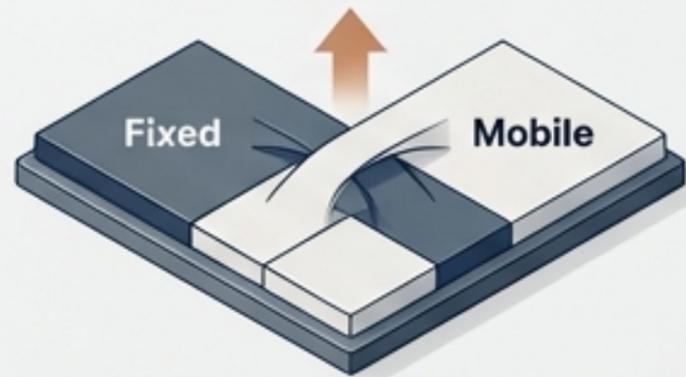

The Strategic Pivot: From Pipe Provider to Spatial Orchestrator

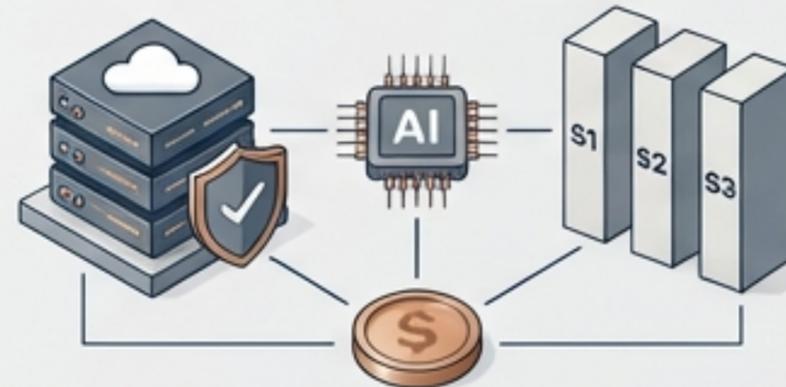
Horizon 1 (2025–2027) Stabilize & Expand

Focus: Fixed-Mobile Convergence (FMC) and the SME market.
Goal: Stop margin erosion.



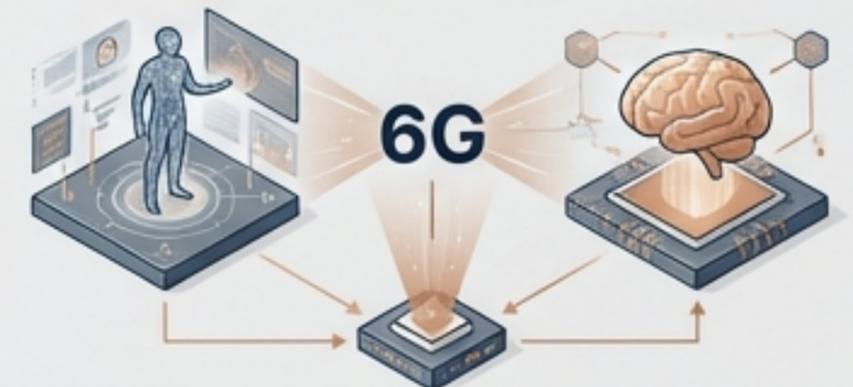
Horizon 2 (2028–2030) Intelligence & Sovereignty

Focus: Sovereign Cloud, AI-driven operations, and Network Slicing.
Goal: Monetize the stack.



Horizon 3 (2031–2035+) The Spatial Future

Focus: Industrial Metaverse, 6G, and Holographic Communication.
Goal: Own the interface.



Connectivity is the baseline, not the business model. Future revenue lies in reimagining the network as a platform for presence and intelligence.

The Crisis of Commoditization: The Race to the Bottom



Over-the-top (OTT) players monetize the traffic while Telcos bear the infrastructure costs. With connectivity becoming an undifferentiated commodity, the traditional “Carrier” model guarantees shrinking profitability.

Horizon 1: The SME Wedge & Fixed-Mobile Convergence (FMC)

The Opportunity:

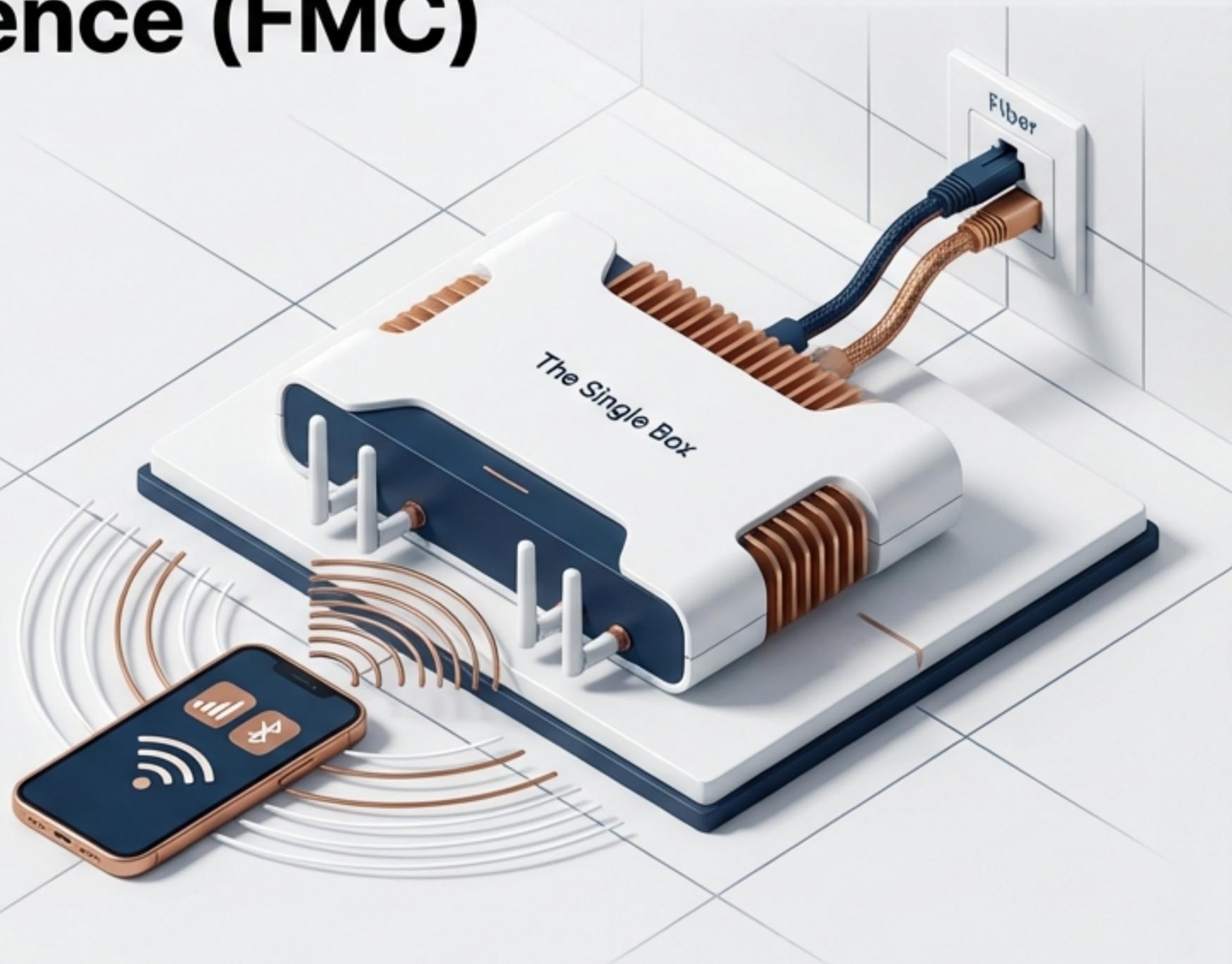
76% of SMEs have not yet adopted full Unified Communications & Collaboration (UC&C) tools.

The Solution: The Single Box.

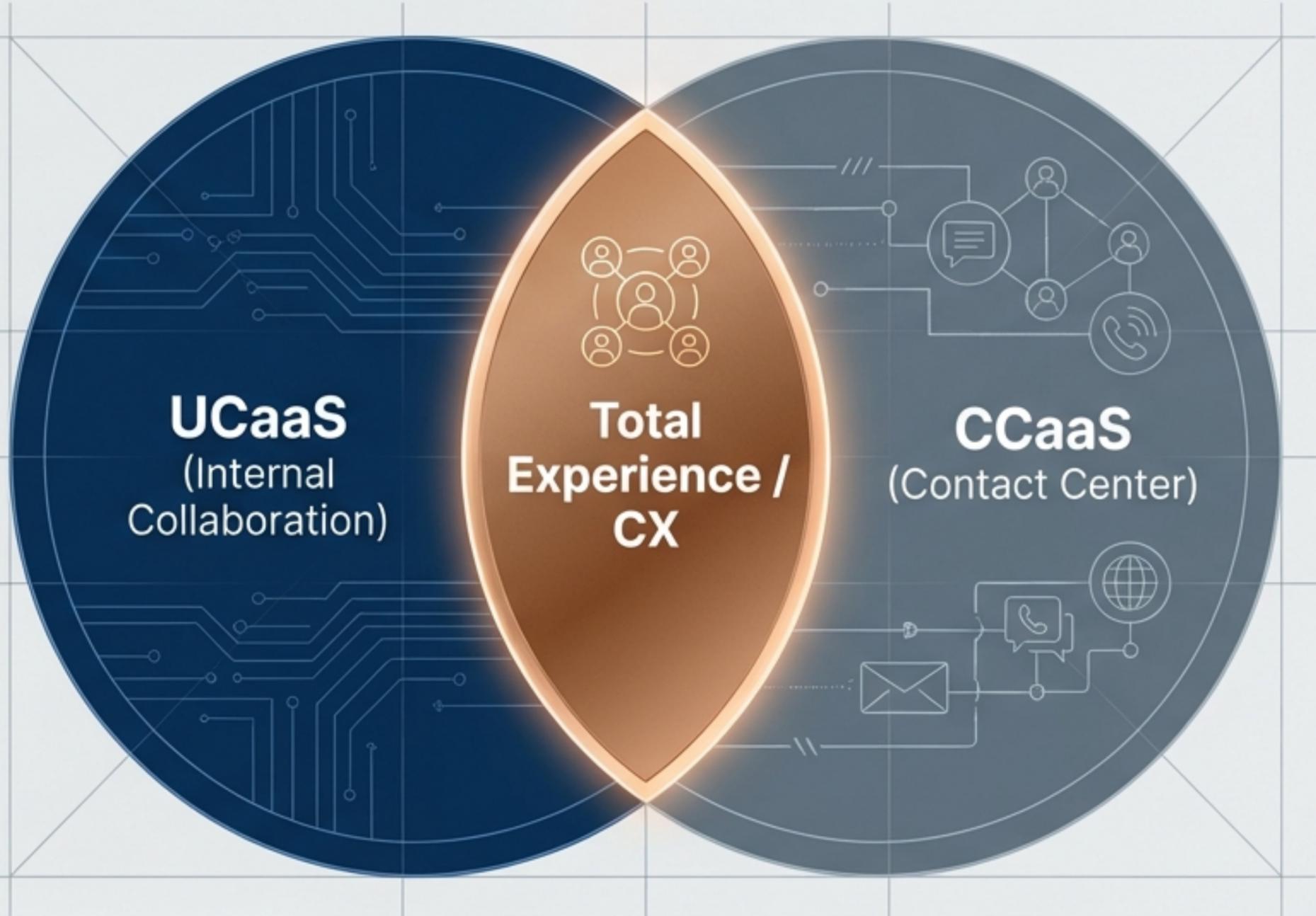
Bundling Fiber + 5G Backup + Cloud Voice into one subscription.

Financial Impact:

- **For the SME:** Reduces telecom expenses by up to 35% over 18 months.
- **Reliability:** Uptime as a Service. Downtime costs small businesses \$12k-\$24k per hour.



Evolving Communications: From Dial Tone to Customer Experience



Market Context:

UCaaS market reaching \$181.84B by 2034.

Strategic Shifts:

1. **Integration:** 61% of organizations now integrate telephony with Microsoft Teams.
2. **Differentiation:** Vertical-specific integrations prevent churn (e.g., HIPAA for Healthcare, POS for Retail).
3. **Convergence:** Merging internal collaboration with external customer support.

The Narrative:

In a fragmented geopolitical world, data residency is the new oil.

Market Trend:



83% of enterprises expect to change deployment approaches, shifting back to hybrid/on-premise in Europe due to CLOUD Act concerns.

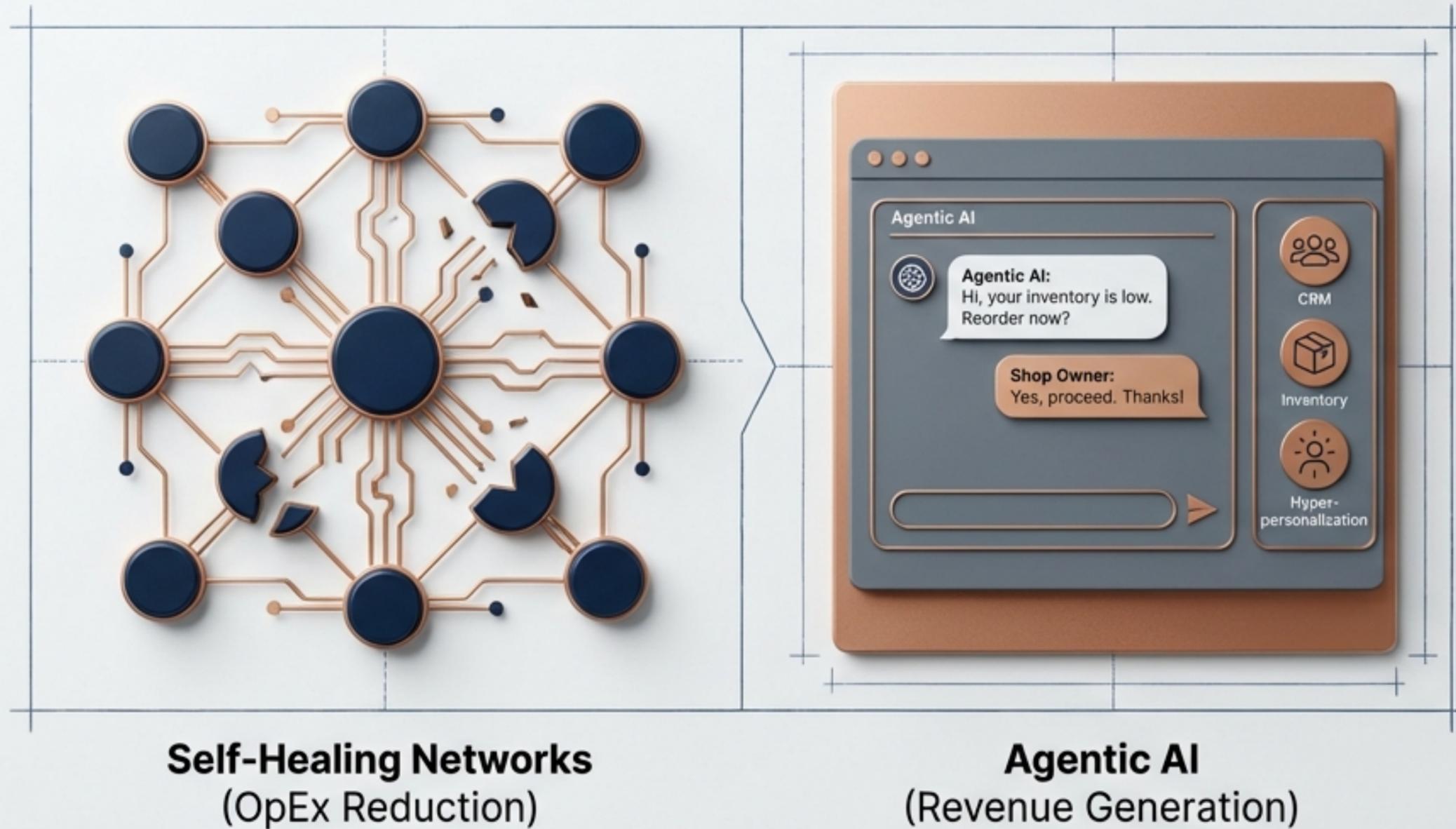
The Telco Advantage:

Telcos offer localized, GDPR-compliant cloud services that Hyperscalers struggle to customize for specific regulatory regimes.



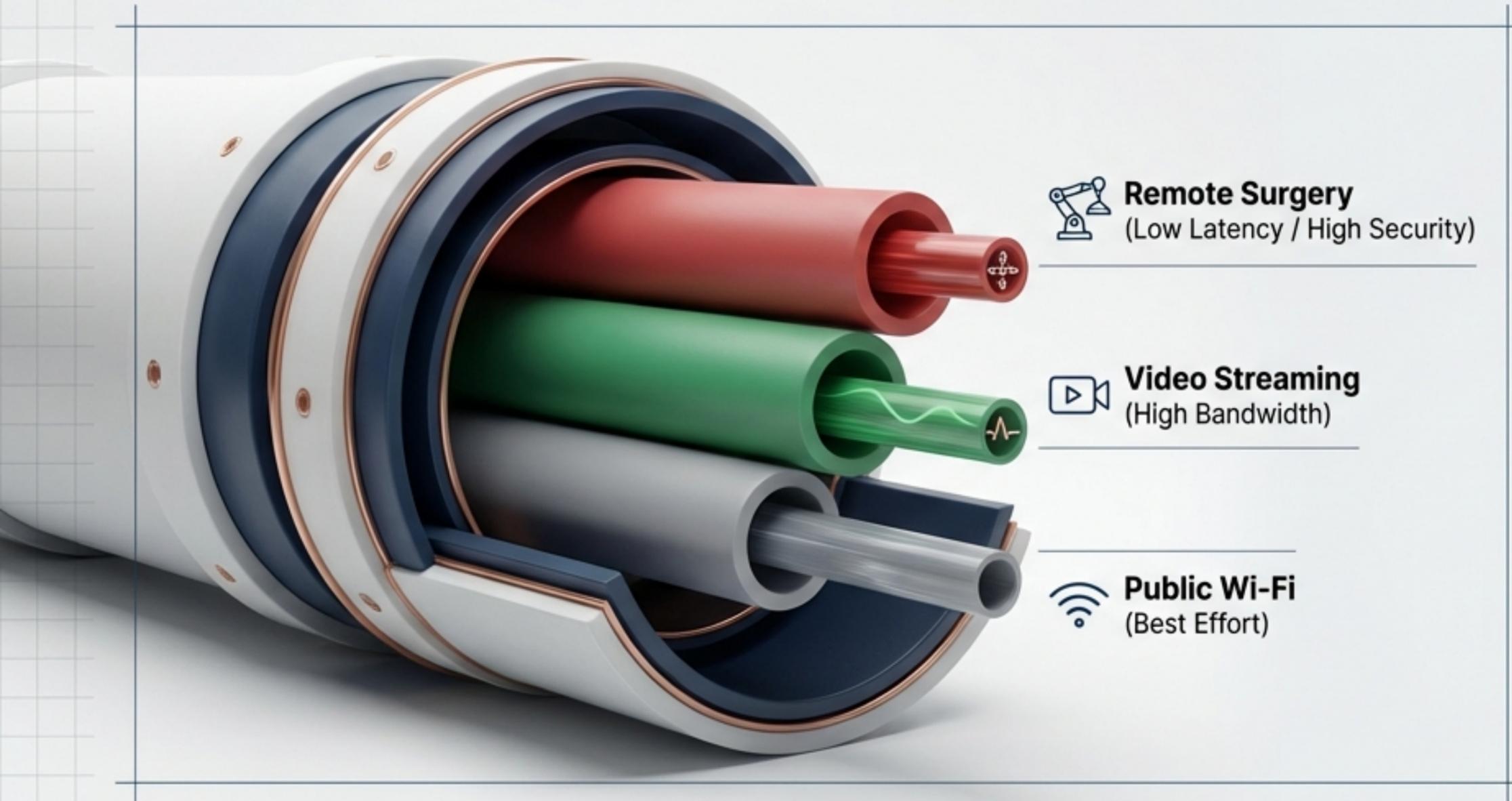
AI & Automation: The Operational Backbone



Competitive Threat:
32% of service providers cite “AI-native platforms” as their biggest threat.

Key Concept: Agentic AI. Moving AI from a support function to a revenue generator. AI agents handle CRM updates, inventory management, and hyper-personalized engagement for SME clients.

Monetizing the Network: Slicing & Managed Services

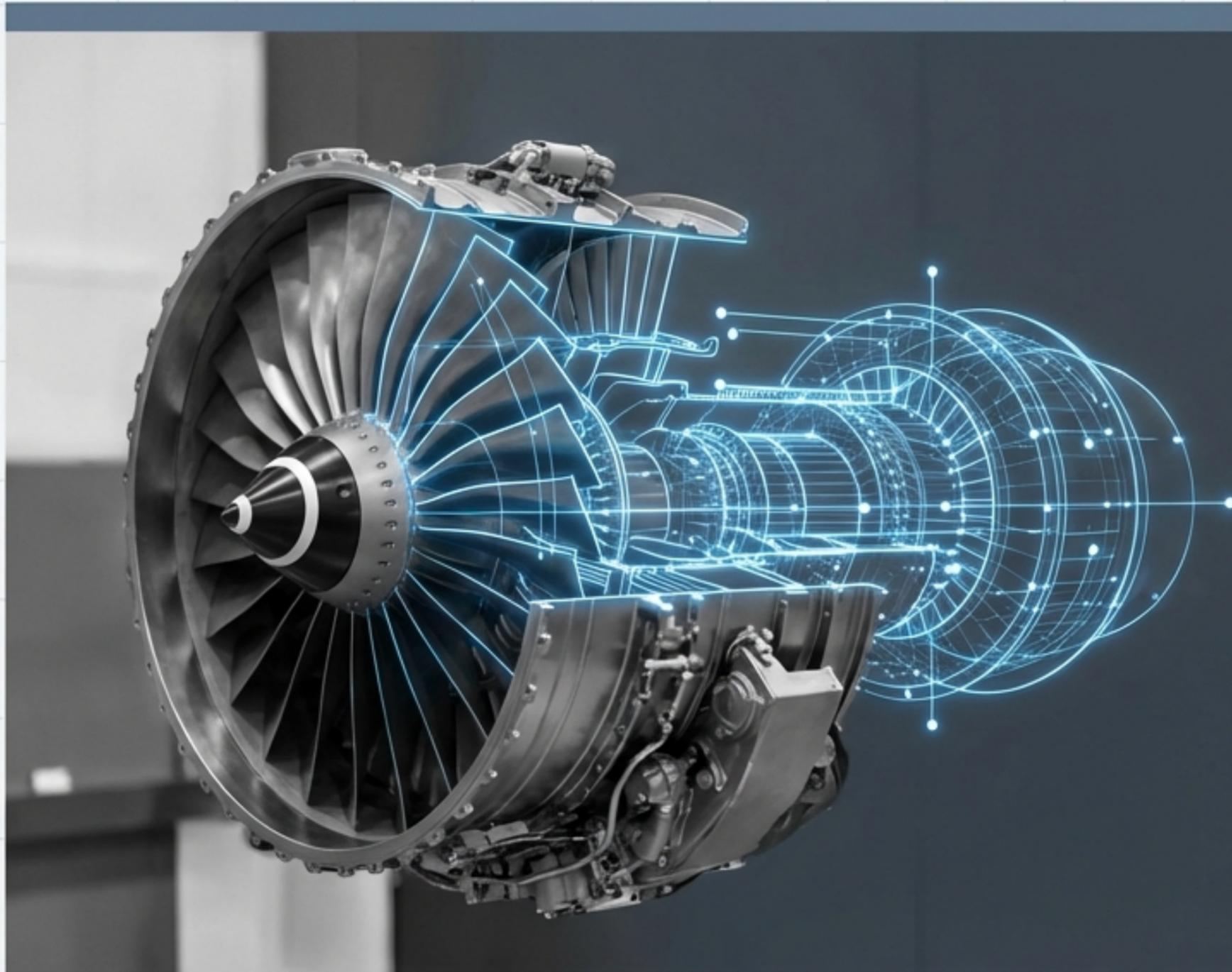


Strategy: Selling Guaranteed Performance
39% of operators plan to use network slices to monetize high-volume OTT traffic.

Private Line + Premium SLAs: Upgrading traditional MPLS to SRv6 for fully automated tenant-level slicing.



Horizon 3: The Industrial Metaverse & Spatial Computing



Market Scale: Industrial Metaverse spending to reach **US\$6.3 billion** by 2030.

Use Cases:

-  - **Immersive Engineering:** Digital twins for predictive maintenance.
-  - **Remote Operations:** VR interfaces for oil rigs and logistics hubs.
-  **Requirement:** Sub-20ms latency via Multi-Access Edge Computing (MEC).

The Device Evolution: From Headsets to Face-Worn Computing



2035 Forecast: 61.5M XR units sold annually.

2045 Forecast: 200M+ XR units sold annually.

92% of XR devices will still remain tethered to the mobile network in 2035.

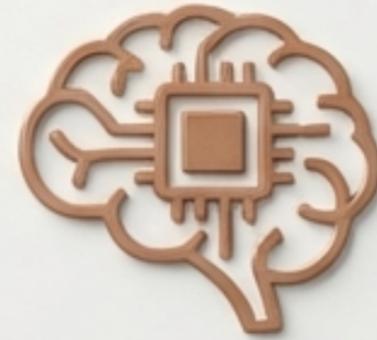

Strategic Recommendations



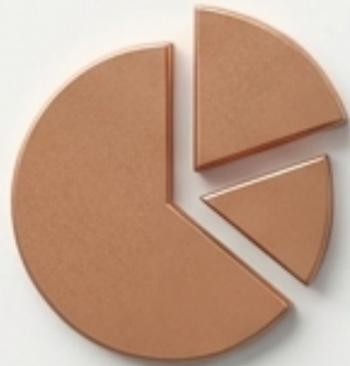
1. Stabilize

Bundle Fiber + 5G + Security for the SME market. Secure the 'single bill' relationship.



2. Smarten

Deploy Agentic AI to shift from cost-cutting to revenue-generating personalized CX.



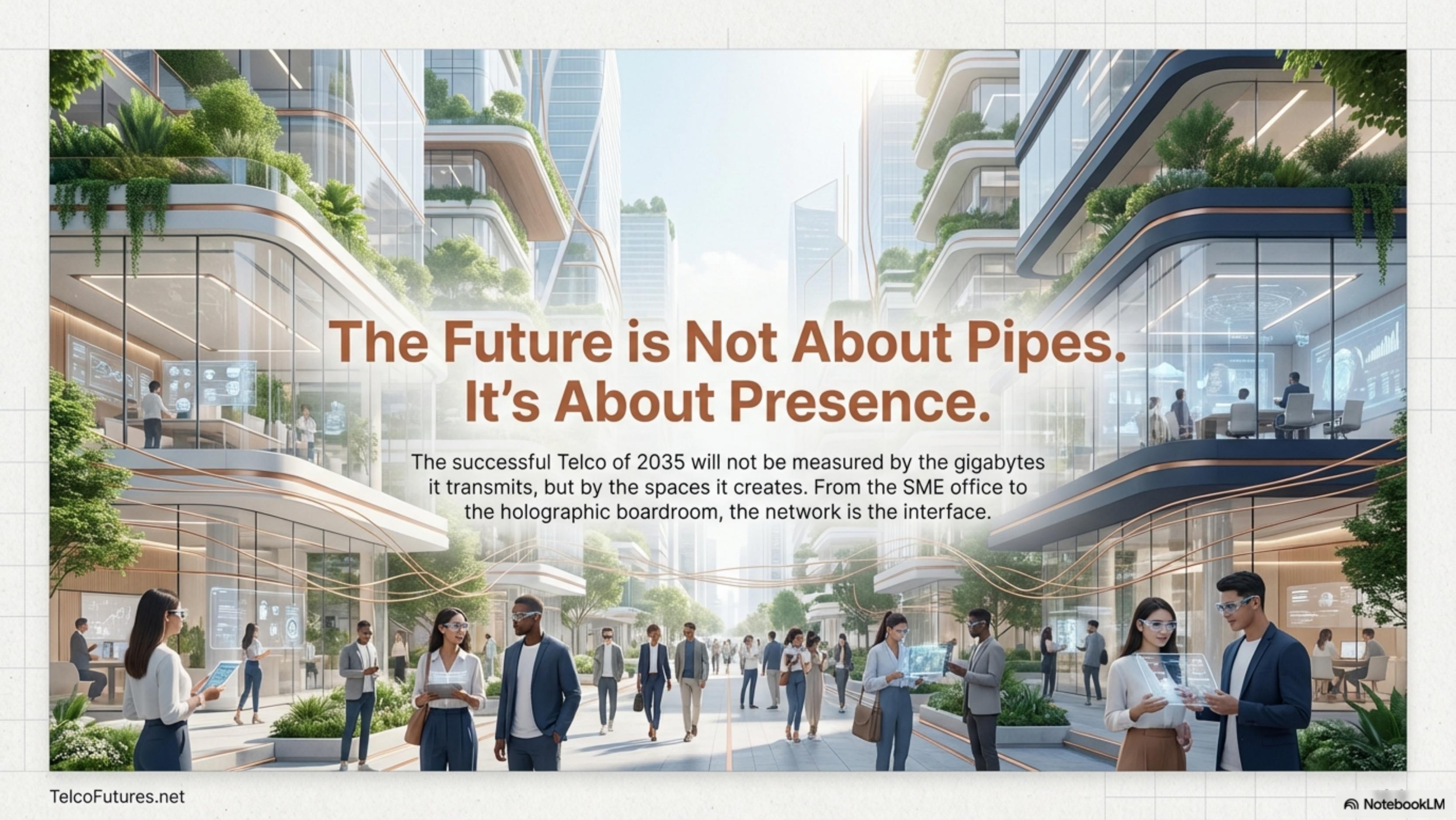
3. Slice

Monetize Quality of Service (QoS) for mission-critical apps. Stop giving away premium performance.



4. Spatial

Invest in Edge Computing (MEC) now to secure low-latency infrastructure for the Metaverse.
